There was nothing to discuss under Old Business.



Commissioner Haefner believes this is unlawful in addition to the unlawful use of data collection with the phone numbers. Chairman Chambers requested our office formulate a letter to the University explaining all of the extra resources we already send to their polling place, and would also like for the University to sign an affidavit swearing that all of the data has been destroyed and not copied.


Under Financial, Director Stream explained the October and November financial reports.
