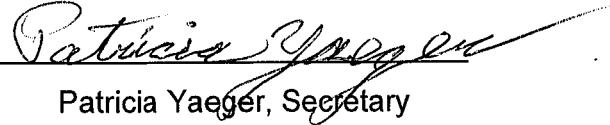
For items VI and VII on the agenda, the June Financial, Budget and Personnel reports were discussed. No action was required by the Board.
